Initially, no equipment to be used.</li> <li>• When it is agreed that the risk level is appropriate, the next phase would include the use of necessary equipment with only the NSC staff member to enter the storeroom and access equipment. All equipment to be wiped down after use.</li> <li>• Indoor access considerations according to phase of return process. Initially, no indoor access whatsoever.
